

- Includes fields for notes
- Annual report as .pdf attachment

Distribution services for Financial Statements

- Subsciption of all Financial Statements as soon as they are registered
 - Free for public authorities(Tax, Statistics)

 Payable for private actors
- Financial statements for one company delivered by email
 - Free when ordered on theough the website- payable when ordered by telephone
- Open API with key figures Free
- API with key figures for public authorities Free- Not available for private actors
- Various tailor-made products charged by hourly rate.
- Automatic feed to service for handling bankruptcy estates (Accounts for several years)

iXBRL reporting developments in Finland

- Nearly 10 000 registered iXBRL financial statements in 2023 via API
 - Still only one compatible software, Fennoa Oy
- Limited liability companies (Oy), Foundations added to the API
- Experimentation, Creating financial statements in digital format
 - Oscar Software Oy and Admicom Finland Oy
 - Gather information on resources used and how time consuming the development of iXBRL functionality is
 - What is a sufficient level of structuredness with notes?
- Validator
- Web based instance document creation tool
- Notification via Business Information System

Legislation

- CSRD implementation to national legistlation, Government proposal has been processed by Parliament
 - Changes to Accounting Act and Auditing Act
 - National expansion for companies that will be reporting sustainability report will have to report the entire annual accounts in XHTML format
 - iXBRL tagging timeframe still uncertain
 - Around 1500 companies are in scope, PIE and large companies
- SBR taxonomy will be updated with new entry points
 - Financial Institution
 - Insurance Institution
 - Co-operatives
- New taxonomies for reporting to PRH
 - ESEF
 - Auditors Report
